

13 km and 20 km from Lynn Canyon Circuit 8, Richard Juryn, Baden-Powell

Getting to the Trailhead

Take Lynn Valley Road exit from Upper Levels Hwy. Follow Lynn Valley Road north and turn right on Peters Road into park. Park in parking lot **at bottom**. (No pay parking in winter.)

Trailhead

Cross Suspension Bridge, head to gazebo.

Suspension Bridge

- Walk across the Suspension Bridge.
- Keep right over boardwalk, turn left at Tjunction. Head north to gazebo.
- Head toward Rice Lake.

Rice Lake (1 1/2 loops)

- Turn RIGHT toward lake at first entrance.
- Going counter-clockwise, do a full loop around lake, then continue for a second time but only half a loop.
- At the north end of lake watch for exit to Seymour Valley Trailway.
- Turn RIGHT onto paved road (by outhouses).
 REGROUP

Circuit 8

- Turn LEFT onto Circuit 8 (at signpost).
- Cross old road. Stay on main trail as it veers left.
- At Y-junction, turn LEFT (do not go right which goes down to Fisherman's).
- At T-junction, turn RIGHT to loop around the ridge.
- Keep RIGHT to get back to Y-junction (it's visible from this turnoff. Left goes down to Fisherman's).
- Follow Circuit 8 back to paved road. Cross road.
- Follow trail back to Seymour Valley Trailway road.
- Turn LEFT onto road and arrive back at gazebo.

REGROUP

Suspension Bridge Trail to Lillooet Rd

- Head into Suspension Bridge Trail.
- Just before the trail veers down to the right, turn LEFT onto connector to Lillooet Road.
- Cross Lillooet Road.

Berm

- Turn RIGHT onto berm (trail that follows the road).
- Watch for LEFT turn toward Richard Juryn Trail (look for Camp Brick Bypass sign).

Richard Juryn

Head up trail to T-junction (post).

REGROUP

- Turn LEFT and cross big rock. Descend.
- At T-junction, turn RIGHT to stay on Richard Juryn East side.
- Follow Richard Juryn Trail.
- Cross Baden-Powell and keep straight.
- You arrive at the berm at Lillooet Road.

Berm and Diamond

- Turn LEFT onto berm.
- Follow berm to crossing at the Park gate.
- Cross Lillooet Road onto Diamond Trail.

REGROUP

 Follow Diamond Trail to T-junction at Baden-Powell Trail.

Baden-Powell


- Turn LEFT onto BP only as far as signpost.
- Turn RIGHT down the stairs on BP and head through marsh.

Twin Falls Bridge

Rev: January 1, 2024

- Turn left and cross Twin Falls Bridge.
- Keep right and you end up back at the parking lot.

13 km FINISHED - STRETCH





20 km-REGROUP & CONTINUE

Twin Falls Bridge

- At lower parking lot, find Twin Falls Bridge Trail. Head down, keeping fence on left.
- Cross bridge and head right onto Baden-Powell.

Baden-Powell

 At post at top of climb (reads 0.5 km to Lillooet Rd), turn RIGHT onto Sea to Sky Trail.

Sea to Sky

- Starts out level and then steep descent for a short ways. Lots of boardwalks.
- IMPORTANT. Watch for new wooden fencing with Environmentally Sensitive Area signs.



REGROUP

- Turn LEFT and head up rocky steps.
- Short climb. Cross bridge (we made this bridge in 2012! See photo.).




Steep climb. Think happy thoughts! REGROUP

To Diamond Trail (See Inset)

- At Y-junctions, keep LEFT.
- At junction with log in middle, go straight.





- You arrive at wider gravel Diamond Trail.
- Turn RIGHT and it curves to Lillooet Road.

Lillooet Road Berm

• Cross road and turn LEFT onto berm.

REGROUP

Richard Juryn Trail (West Side)

- Take first RIGHT onto Richard Juryn Trail.
- You come to Baden-Powell. Turn LEFT.
- Take first RIGHT on Richard Juryn West Trail.
- Keep left on this trail to junction and ROCK FACE. Turn LEFT downhill.
- Watch for next LEFT to take down to berm.
- Turn RIGHT on berm and follow it to road crossing before filtration plant (parking lot).
- Cross Lillooet Road.

Suspension Bridge Trail

- At T-junction, turn LEFT and head down Suspension Bridge Trail to the bridge.
- Option: if Suspension Bridge is too busy to cross, head down and cross at Twin Falls Bridge.
