

## 12 km from Hyannis

### Fisherman's, Bridle Path, Baden-Powell, Old Buck

#### Getting to the Trailhead

Follow Mount Seymour Parkway to Berkley. Turn north onto Berkley and head to the end of the street. Park near the sports field at top of Berkley. Porta Potty available. Do NOT park on Hyannis.

#### Trailhead

- Find Baden-Powell Trail on south side of Hyannis Drive.

#### Baden Powell

- Turn down Baden-Powell until you come to the intersection of Fisherman's Trail.

#### Fisherman's Trail

- Turn right on Fisherman's Trail.
  - Watch for second turnoff onto Mystery Creek Trail.
- REGROUP**

#### Mystery Creek

- Follow Mystery Creek Trail to Powerline.
- Turn RIGHT onto Powerline Trail.

#### Powerline

- Follow Powerline and cross Mystery Creek Bridge.
  - Turn RIGHT onto Hyannis Trail right after the bridge.
- REGROUP**

#### Hyannis Trail

- Take first LEFT onto Bridle Path.

#### Bridle Path

- Follow Bridle Path to the junction of Baden-Powell (bridge and big rock).
- REGROUP (Take Photos)**

#### Baden-Powell

- Turn LEFT onto Baden-Powell and you reach a T-junction with a big sign (kiosk).

- Turn LEFT to continue along Baden-Powell up "the Seymour grind".
- At top of climb stay **right** on Baden-Powell (do NOT take connector to Powerline).
- At intersection of Baden-Powell and Mushroom...  
**REGROUP**
- Turn RIGHT to stay on Baden-Powell heading downhill and you reach Old Buck.  
**REGROUP**

#### Old Buck

- Turn RIGHT at Old Buck and continue downhill.

#### Bridle Path to Baden Powell

- Turn RIGHT onto Bridle Path.
- You will come to a sharp right turn at a fence.
- Continue along Bridle Path. Watch for markers.
- At trail junction with Severed-D (aka Good Samaritan), turn left, cross stream.
- Turn LEFT and follow Bridle Path down (long route).
- At the bottom of the downhill (fork), keep right.
- At the big sign (kiosk) turn LEFT.  
**REGROUP**
- You come to a marked fork for Baden-Powell and Bridle Path (big rock and creek).
- Keep straight on Baden-Powell to Hyannis Drive.
- Head back to the sports field on Berkley.
